



## **MONDAY: REMEMBRANCE AND PRAYER**

### **Description:**

On Monday, October 6th, 2025, CUFI High School Clubs will educate their peers with a presentation about Hamas' attack on October 7th, 2023. The club will pray for Israel and the Jewish community, guided by a ready-made presentation. If there are still hostages in captivity, yellow pins provided by CUFI will be distributed and worn throughout the week in remembrance of the hostages.

### **Resources Needed:**

Yellow pins

### **Instructions:**

CUFI High School Club members pass out and wear yellow pins to remember the hostages. Student leaders will present a CUFI-made slide show presentation to their club. The club will need to secure a computer, Smart Board, or projector with sound capabilities to present.

## **TUESDAY: MEMORIAL SERVICE AND VIGIL**

### **Description:**

On Tuesday, October 7th, 2025, CUFI High School Clubs will hold a Memorial Service and Vigil. CUFI will provide a guide and prepared remarks for the service. The prayer vigil can be held during the club's preferred meeting time, in a school-wide assembly, or can be implemented in a chapel service.

**Instructions:**

Use the following prayer vigil guide to pray together as a group. Assign each speech to a student and hand out the flameless candles. In an assembly or chapel setting, the flameless candles may be displayed across the platform or held by ten students for the duration of the service. Service length is approximately 30 minutes.

**WEDNESDAY: PRAY FOR ISRAEL WALL**

October 8th, 2025, CUFI High School Clubs will replicate the experience of the Western Wall with a prayer event. Like religious Jews in Jerusalem write prayers on paper and put them in the Western Wall, students will create a Western Wall out of a poster and place prayers on sticky notes on the poster. Students can then pray for what they wrote on the sticky notes aloud as a group.

**Instructions:**

CUFI will provide students with a digital image of the Western Wall, and sticky notes. CUFI High School Clubs can write "Prayer Wall for Israel" on the board. Students will write prayers for Israel and the Jewish community on sticky notes and attach them to the board. Students can then pray for what they wrote on the sticky notes aloud as a group. The students can keep this board for their club to remind them to pray for Israel in the future.

## **THURSDAY: FACES OF THE FESTIVAL**

### **Description:**

On Thursday, October 9th, 2025, CUFI High School Clubs will hear stories from Supernova Music Festival survivors and parents of hostages taken at the festival through a provided slide show presentation given by a student leader. Stories of the hostages will be highlighted like that of 23-year-old Hersh Goldberg-Polin, an American Israeli who was kidnapped by Hamas at the Nova Festival.

### **Instructions:**

Student leaders will present the CUFI-made slide show presentation to their club. The club will need to secure a computer, Smart Board, or projector with sound capabilities to present.

## **FRIDAY: WRITE LETTERS TO LONE IDF SOLDIERS**

### **Description:**

On Friday, October 10th, 2025, CUFI High School Clubs will write letters of support and encouragement to Lone Soldiers, IDF soldiers who don't have family in Israel to help and support them during their service.

### **Resources Needed:**

Sample Letter

Paper for Cards

Pens and Markers

Envelope to Return to CUFI Office with return address label and postage paid

### **Instructions:**

In the cards, students can show their support to the men and women of the Israel Defense Force who don't have families nearby. These cards should remind these Lone Soldiers that someone cares about them. If high school students use scriptures, they should only use scriptures from the Old Testament (Hebrew Bible) since these cards are meant for Jewish people. The cards written by students will then be gathered and placed in an envelope with a return address label provided by CUFI and sent to the CUFI headquarters in San Antonio, Texas, where they will be sent to Lone Soldiers.
